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Why we have problems with the implementation of environmental legislation?

increasing number of normative acts that have direct applicability or need to be transposed

"epic in its size and scope and Talmudic in its complexity" Robertson (1998)

- deliberate and active non-compliance,
- ➤ a passive non-compliance, determined by the lack of the knowledge of the implemented legislation, identified as being:
 - (i) a major factor behind enforcement and compliance failures and
 - (ii) a passive failure in enforcing the norms

Research objectives

In order to facilitate the information transmission and the education for the environmental legislation

- novel approach of the abundant European and Romanian legislation for waste management,
- innovative tools for the adequate application of the environmental legislation for the waste management
- 1. to make a research and to present an inventory of the normative acts needed to be known and applied, to demonstrate how vast is the waste management related legislation;
- 2. to develop a novel systematization (schemes) of the normative acts being of interest and applied at different levels: by local administration, by legal persons, or by individuals;
- 3. to present the production of OERs, as video presentations and text related documents (including the developed schemes), that will be uploaded and available for a large audience, on the electronic educational platform organized in the frame of the Environmental Education OERs for Rural Citizens (EnvEdu OERs) project.



The large number of normative acts

We used:

- the official website for the European Union legislation was consulted <u>www.eur-lex.europa.eu</u>
- the advanced search tool and filters available on the platform

We found:

4151 - acts related to waste management at EU level

229 - REGULATION

163 - DECISION

93 - DIRECTIVES



The minimum number of normative acts

Research on: - EU strategies regarding the waste management,

Environmental Action Programs (EAP)

Identified - the basic normative act on waste management at EU level and also in Iceland

DIRECTIVE 2008/98/EC ON WASTE MANAGEMENT

Its connexion under the aspect of legislative references:

- 8 Regulations
 - 2 Decisions
- 12 Directives 13 national transposition acts have been identified
- 7 national normative acts with direct involvement in waste management




The minimum number of normative acts


- General obligations for the local administration regarding the waste management

- Regulations and obligations addressed to the individuals




General obligations for the local administration WM



Obligations for the local administration – specific activity




