
The conference is organized by a consortium that includes Politehnica University of Timisoara (UPT), Norwegian Institute of Bioeconomy Research (NIBIO), University of Green Development (HGUt) and be held at Small Hall of the Senate, the Rector's Building of the Politehnica University of Timisoara, 2nd Victoriei Square no. 2, Timisoara, 300006, Romania.

The purpose of the conference is to support and enhance the exchange of expertise between Romania and the EEA countries regarding sustainable urban development as well as the identification of ways through which the culture of green spaces and the culture of promoting environmental values can contribute to obtaining modern, green, sustainable cities despite technical, socio-economic and environmental challenges.

The conference is organized under **EEA 914 project.** – *Think Green. The culture of sustainable urban development*. The project benefits from a grant worth 50,673 euros from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway through the EEA and Norwegian grants. The EEA and Norwegian grants represent the contribution of Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway to a green, competitive and inclusive Europe. There are two general objectives: reducing economic and social disparities in Europe and strengthening bilateral relations between the donor states and 15 EU states in central and southern Europe and the Baltic states. The three donor states cooperate closely with the EU under the Agreement on the European Economic Area (EEA). Between 1994 and 2014, donor states contributed €3.3 billion through consecutive grant schemes. For the period 2014-2021, the EEA and Norwegian Grants amount to €2.8 billion.
